The MIDDLETOWN and NEW JERSEY RAILWAY HISTORICAL SOCIETY was established in 1994 to preserve and share the history of the MIDDLETOWN and NEW JERSEY RAILWAY and predecessor companies MIDDLETOWN, UNIONVILLE & WATER GAP RAILROAD and the MIDDLETOWN & UNIONVILLE RAILROAD. Since a railroad cannot exist in isolation, especially a short line, this history must also encompass connecting carriers such as the Middletown & Crawford, New Jersey Midland, New York, Susquehanna & Western, New York & Oswego Midland, New York, Ontario & Western, Erie / Erie Lackawanna, Conrail and Norfolk & Southern in so far as their relationship with the M&NJ and its predecessors.

The MIDDLETOWN and NEW JERSEY RAILWAY HISTORICAL SOCIETY is dedicated to preserving the artifacts, historical records and experiences of the railroad's employees, customers and their employees, passengers and all whose lives were affected by the M&NJ and its predecessors. The M&NJRHS recognizes that without people in the communities, businesses and farms there would be no railroad at all. We have meetings at 7:30 pm on the second Friday of September, November, February, April and June. Meetings are currently held at the Maybrook Railroad Museum on Schipps Lane in Maybrook NY and feature Society business and entertainment. Our Society has started an Archive and preserved the 1916 right of way maps of the MIDDLETOWN and UNIONVILLE RAILROAD. We have a sales table at various railroad shows and participate in the local events. Membership benefits include special prices on maps, books, etc.. All of our members receive our quarterly newsletter The Unionville Flyer. The newsletter is available in digital (note: digital copy is in color) or B&W printed hard copy. This newsletter contains current and historical articles, including copies of railroad documents, covering the M&NJ, M&U, M&UWG, and connecting carriers.
